Position Overview

The Pianist / Accompanist position will collaborate with the Lead Pastor to select and perform appropriate music for worship services and special events. This role requires a skilled musician with a deep understanding of liturgical music and the ability to enhance the worship experience through music.

Essential Functions

- Work closely with the Lead Pastor to choose music that aligns with the themes and liturgical calendar.
- Play the piano during worship services, including prelude, offertory, postlude, hymns, and other musical selections.
- Accompany the Chancel Choir and other musical ensembles during rehearsals and performances as requested.
- Participate in planning and executing special services and events, such as weddings, funerals, and holiday celebrations (i.e. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Christmas Eve).
- Request regular preventive maintenance services to ensure musical instruments are in good working condition.

- High school diploma / GED and two (2) years of relevant experience
- Proven experience as a church pianist or similar role
- Proficiency in playing the piano and other keyboard instruments, organ experience is desired
- Strong knowledge of liturgical music and hymnody
- Ability to collaborate effectively with church leadership, musicians, and choirs
- Excellent communication and organizational skills
- Commitment to spiritual leadership through music ministry.
- Demonstrated professionalism and strong work ethic
- Regular and reliable attendance
