CERTIFIED LAY MINISTRY

"But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation. God's own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light." - 1 Peter 2:9

Laity have long been the stronghold of Methodism and essential to the Wesleyan movement. John Wesley recognized early the gifts of the laity and called them out raising up new leaders as exhorters, class leaders, and lay preachers. The Global Methodist Church also recognizes the importance of such a lay led movement and has made certified lay ministry a priority in its foundational stages of ministry. Therefore, we have a vital leadership path for lay people as a Certified Lay Minister. Beginning on June 1, we will be holding a virtual lay ministry school which will fulfill all the educational requirements for certification. Our 2024 school will be held via ZOOM and a link will be provided prior to each class session. Classes will be one Saturday a month for six months from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. CDT.



She has served on various boards and commissions promoting missions, outreach, and the Global Methodist Church.
