2-Have you heard about the TCAT? No, it's not a four-dimensional tessering cat from a Madeleine L'Engle book. It's actually a group of people who are gathering together to help organize an Upper Midwest Conference of the Global Methodist Church!

GMC Organizers (The Transitional Leadership Council) are working with pastors and laypeople to form Transitional Conference Advisory Teams (TCATs) in various regions. The TCAT will have a variety of responsibilities as Transitional Districts and Transitional Conferences are formed. The TCAT will work with the TLC to "when an area has a critical mass of local churches and leaders to form a provisional annual conference, set-up transitional boards and committees, and create websites and leverage social media platforms to make people aware of the potential formation of a provisional annual conference in their area."
